Supporting Survivors of Abuse and Brain Injury through Research (SOAR) works with academic researchers, health care providers, and community partners to investigate the intersection of brain injury and intimate partner violence, and apply scientific evidence to increase awareness and improve supports and services. Founded in 2016, SOAR is a registered charity and the only organization in Canada with a singular focus on brain injury from intimate partner violence.
